

Shibori Table topper

The instructions here are for cutting and assembly the table topper.

Finish quilting and binding instructions are the same as any quilted project.

Fabric requirements; Three 8" (*Shibori) printed squares, 1/2 yard complementary fabric yardage, 25" square of thin quilt batting, 25" square of fabric for backing. (*doesn't have to be Shibori)



This easy table topper measures approx. 22" square

Cutting instructions:

Cut three (Shibori pieces) or printed fabric into three 8" squares. Cut two of the 8" squares in half diagonally. From your print (or solid) yardage - cut two 11-1/4" squares. Cut these two squares in half diagonally. From your yardage cut three 2" x 42" strips.

Assembly: *all seam allowances are 1/4"*

Using a 1/4" seam allowance, stitch a 2" strip to all four sides of the center 8" Shibori square.



Trim the strips even at the ends.
Your block should now look like this:
