

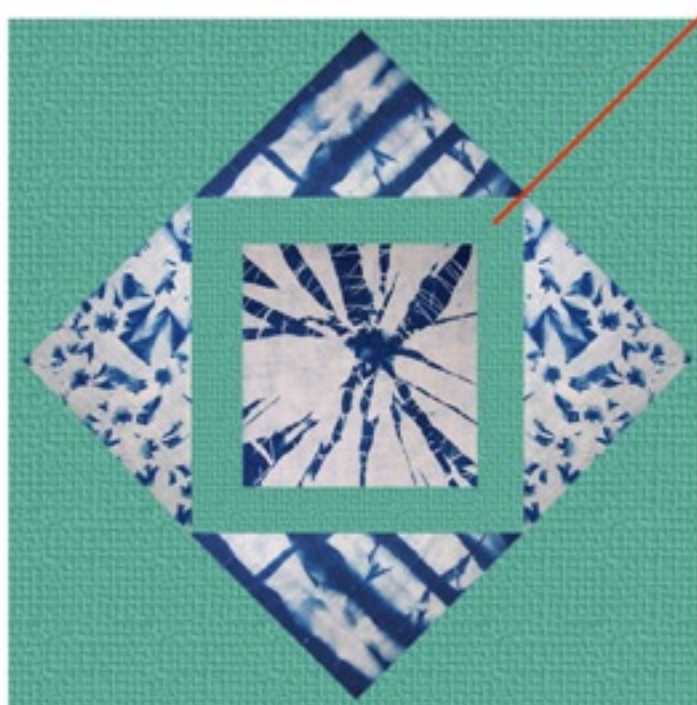
## Shibori Table topper ~ page 2

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Next, stitch the four (Shibori) triangles to each side of the center block. Your piece should now look like this: Note ~ to center the triangles correctly on the center block, fold the triangle to find the center (denoted as red line in illustration) and also fold the block in half to mark the center points. Then match centers, pin before stitching in place.



Repeat this procedure to add the four larger print triangles to all four sides of the piece. Now you just need to layer this with your quilt batting and backing and quilt by hand or machine. After quilting use the remaining 2" strips to make the binding. I recommend using a thin batting for table toppers, table runners and placemats.
